Friday Prayer Guidelines

Players are encouraged, if possible, to register for their rounds on Thursday or Friday morning (to complete round before Jumma prayers).

If the above are not possible then it would be convenient if the desire for a break for Jumma Prayers be advised at the time of registration. The Starter will try to accommodate players wishing to pray in the same group.

Alternatively the Player wishing to pray should prior to starting the round make it clear to his playing partners that he would like a break for prayers and request them to wait for him to rejoin the group after prayers. If any of the playing partners does not wish to discontinue play for prayers then the Player wishing to pray should immediately inform the starter to accommodate the player in another group willing to stop playing for prayers.

Should a group agree to stop playing to accommodate one or more players wishing to offer Jumma prayers, the following should be observed:

- a) The Jumma Prayers are always held at 1.00pm at KGC. The Player/s wishing to pray should break off as near to 12.50 pm as possible with sufficient time to reach the Mosque. All watches in the group should be synchronized.
- b) The Player/s taking the break for prayers must return to the place where play was stopped by 1.15 pm.
- c) The remaining players of the group while waiting should allow any group behind them to pass their group.
- d) After 1.15 pm the group waiting for the player taking the prayer break will continue play and the player/s taking the break having failed to rejoin the group will be dis-qualified.
